

Report of the activity of the Polish Section of ELEC - 2006

March 8, 2006 - Members of the Central Council of Polish Section of ELEC, were guests at the Finals of the School Competition "Resident of the changing Europe" organized by local educational authorities. President of the Polish Section Mr. Maciej Dobrzyniecki gave a lecture relating to the personality of the present-day European;

March 22, 2006 - General Assembly of the members of Polish Section of ELEC in Gdańsk;

April - June 2006 - Several meetings with representants of small and medium enterprises summarizing the use of structural funds for developing SME;

May 18, 2006 - Polish Section of ELEC organized the 1st Baltic Conference "A region with future" held in Gdynia, Poland, under the honorary patronage of the Spokesman of Polish Senate Mr Bogdan Borusewicz; The main aim of the Conference was the presentation of the companies from the Baltic Region in full growth as well as to point out the problems of the Baltic Region to the public opinion. Polish Section of ELEC believes that Baltic Sea and Baltic Countries need to strengthen its position in UE to be sure there is a proper balance between North and South of Europe;

At present Polish Section works on creating new ELEC's Baltic Commission which would be particularly interested in Baltic Sea Region, its problems and development opportunities.

Following the Central Council desire that new Baltic Commission would be functioning under the leadership of Polish Section of ELEC, during this Conference Members of ELEC International were invited to familiarize with the Baltic Region and its problems as well as its opportunities for development;

June 2, 2006 - Mr. President Maciej Dobrzyniecki attended the ELEC Central Council in Barcelona;

June 9, 2006 - Meeting with the President of Pomerania, Mr. Jan Kozłowski summarizing absorption of the structural funds developing local labor market and local infrastructure of Pomerania;

July/August 2006 - as in previous years, Polish Section of ELEC participated in the 'Summer Scene Project' of the City Theatre in Gdynia. The main goal of the project was to familiarize Polish audience with the European arts and cultures;

September 22, 2006 - General Assembly of the members of Polish Section of ELEC in Gdańsk; During this Assembly there were elected new members of the Central Council of Polish Section and the President of Polish Section of ELEC;

September 27, 2006 - Members of the Polish Section of ELEC actively participated in the VI International Economic Forum 2006; Forum contributes to establishing economic and political co-operation, to creating the best climate for partnership and sharing views, opinions and experience. The main aim of the Forum is to create new development opportunities for Gdynia and the whole Region through searching for interesting solutions and attractive direction of co-operation between companies, based on the most recent technologies and economic rules; The Forum was held in Gdynia with participation of Members of ELEC and Port of Antwerp as well as Port Valencia;

November 2006 - Meeting with the Director of the Polish Information and Foreign Investment Agency, Mr. Andrzej Kanthak informing about activities of Polish Section of ELEC.

Throughout the year Polish Section of ELEC and its Members actively made an effort to get the interest of Latvian, Finish, Estonian and other Baltic countries representants to join ELEC.

In 2006 Polish Section of ELEC also helped to organize European Days in two primary schools and one high school in Gdańsk.

Members of the Section attended the international meetings and seminars about European Integration.
